

INFOGRAPHIC BRIEF MPS OF THE 12TH NATIONAL PARLIAMENT IN BANGLADESH

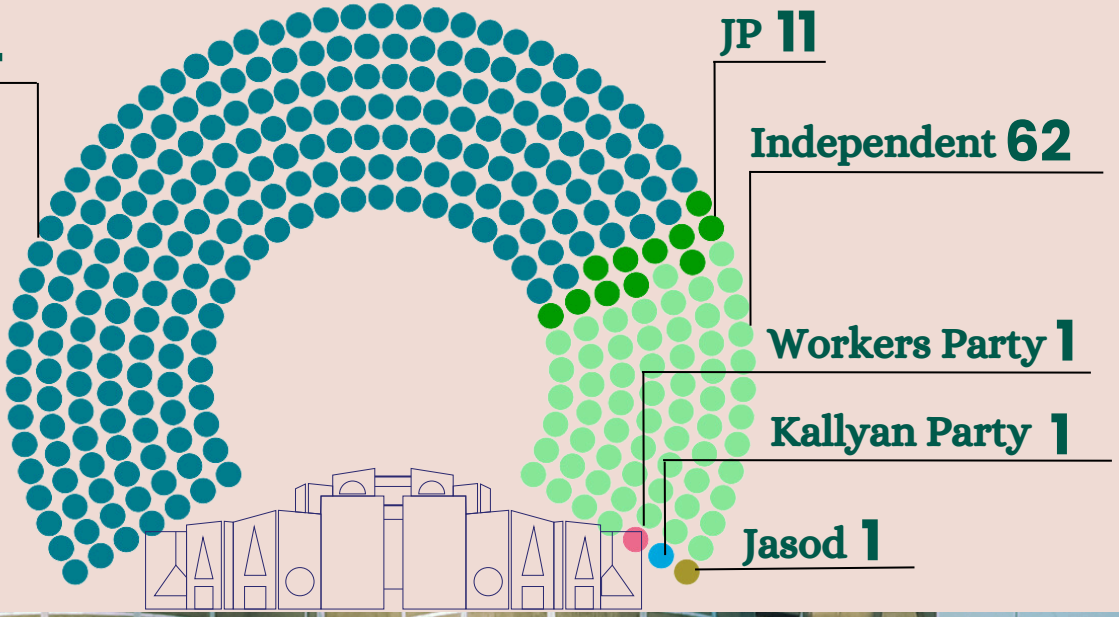
Parliament of Bangladesh (Jatiya Sangsad) consists of 350 seats, of which 300 members are elected directly through first past the post electoral system. The remaining 50 seats are reserved for women and allocated to political parties in proportion to their number of seats in the parliament.. Every five years a general election is held in 300 constituencies. The party with more than half (at least 151) of the seats forms the government. The 12th National Parliament was formed with the winners of the national elections held on 7 January 2024.

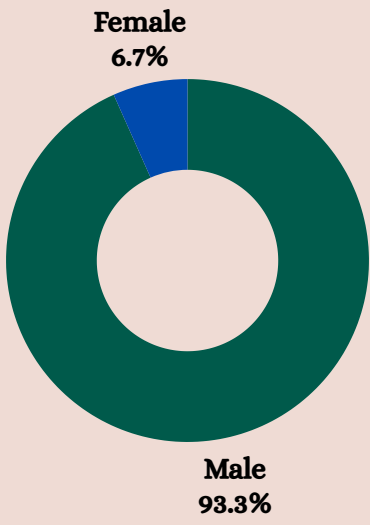

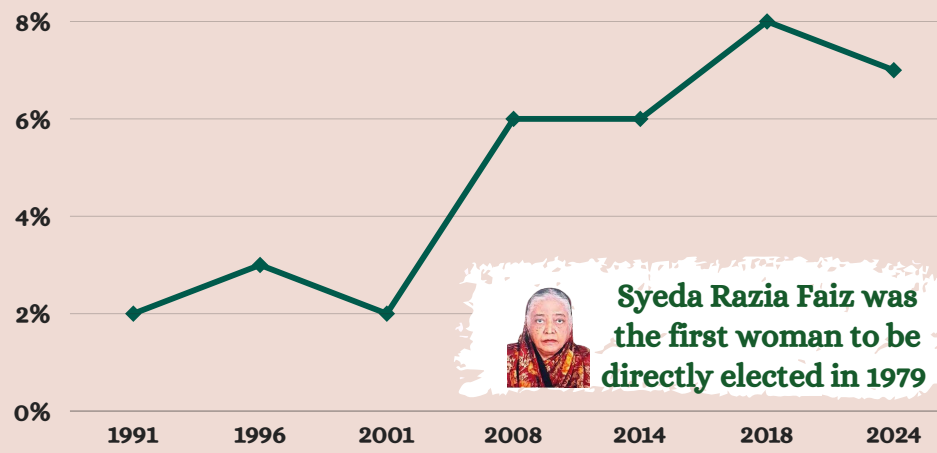

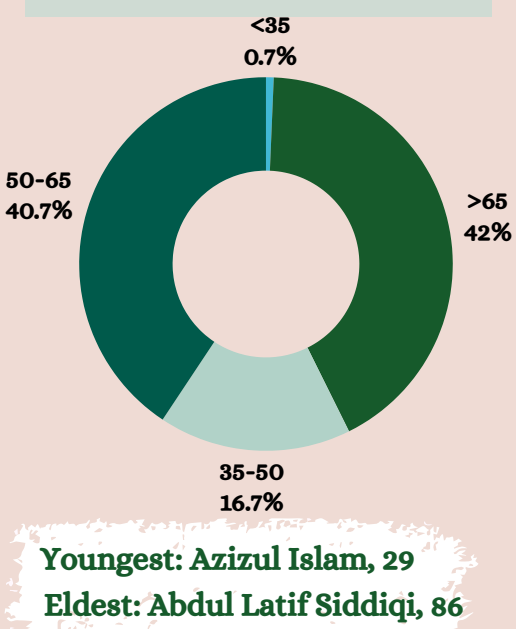
MPS BY SEX



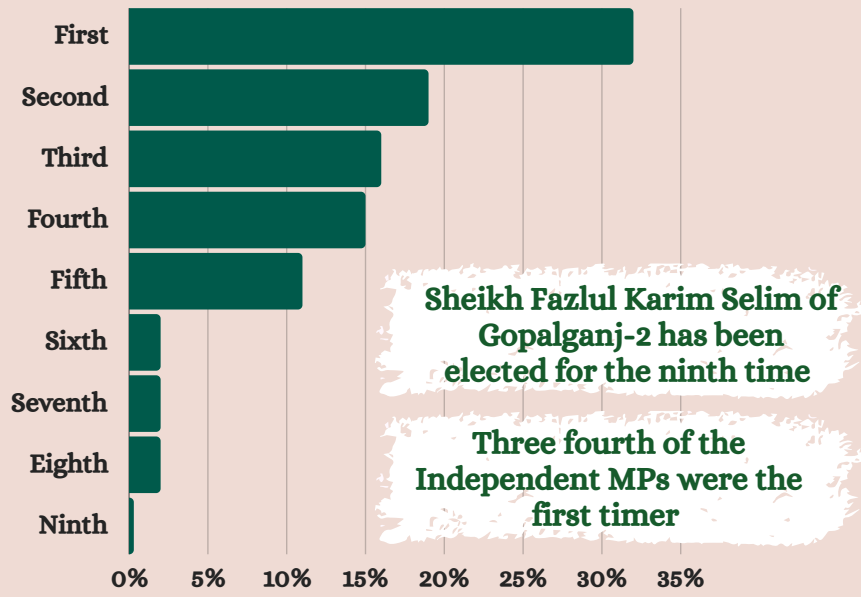
WOMEN IN PARLIAMENT: 1991-2024



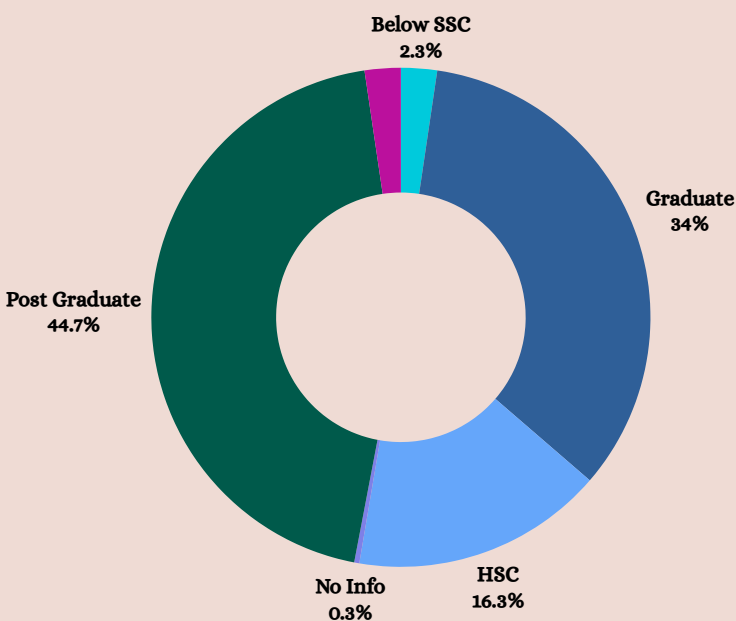

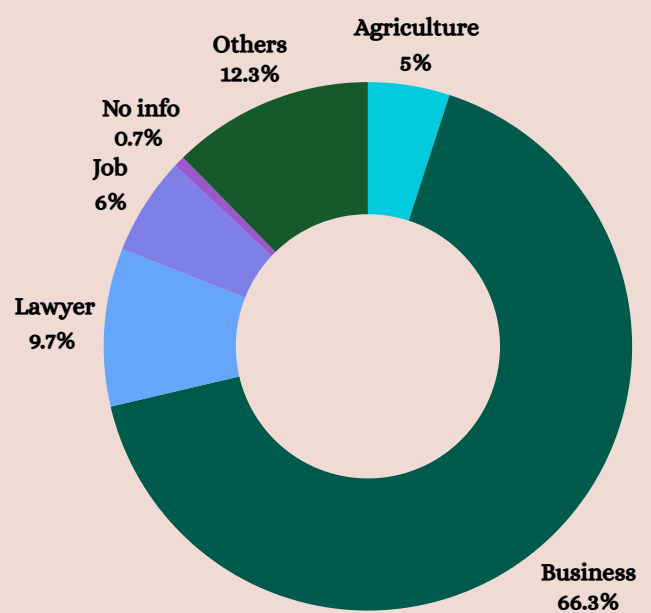

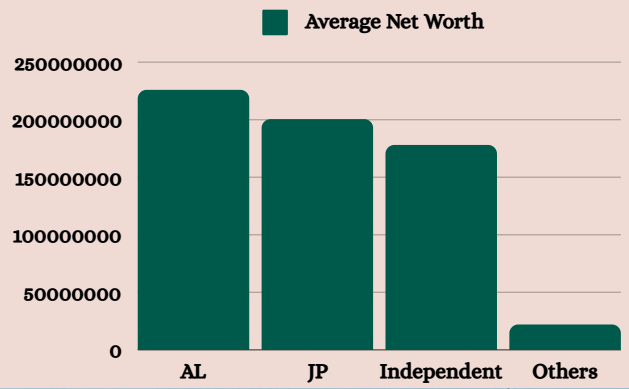
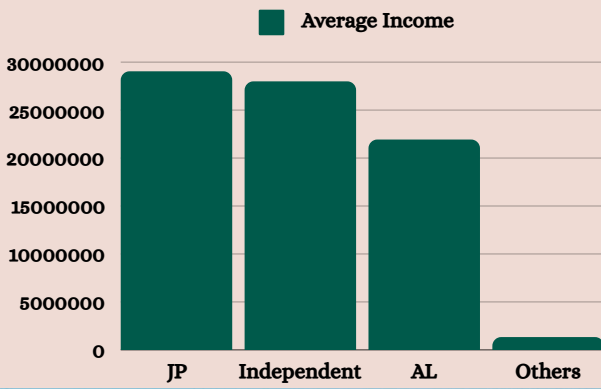

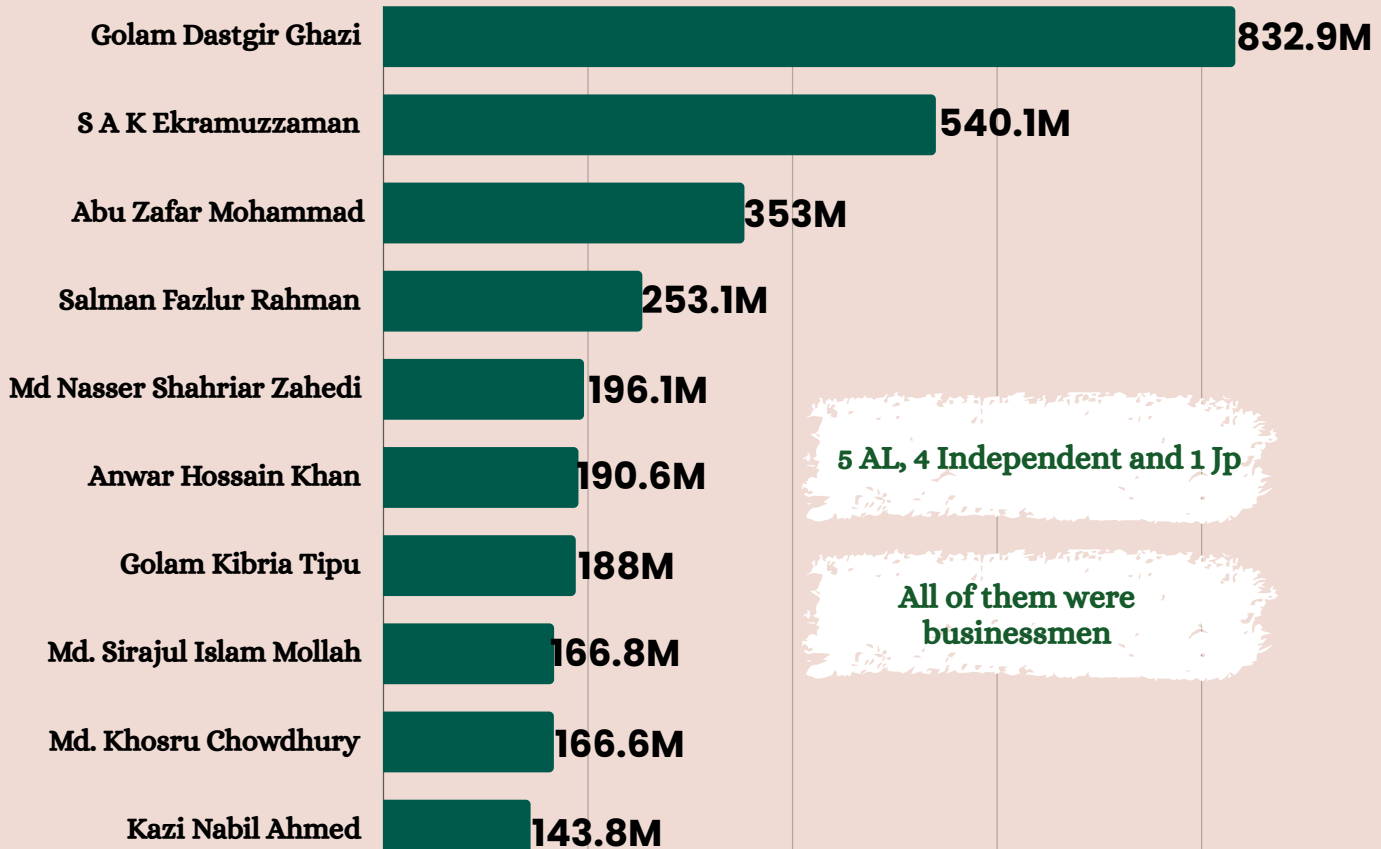

AVERAGE INCOME AND NET WORTH OF MPS BY PARTY

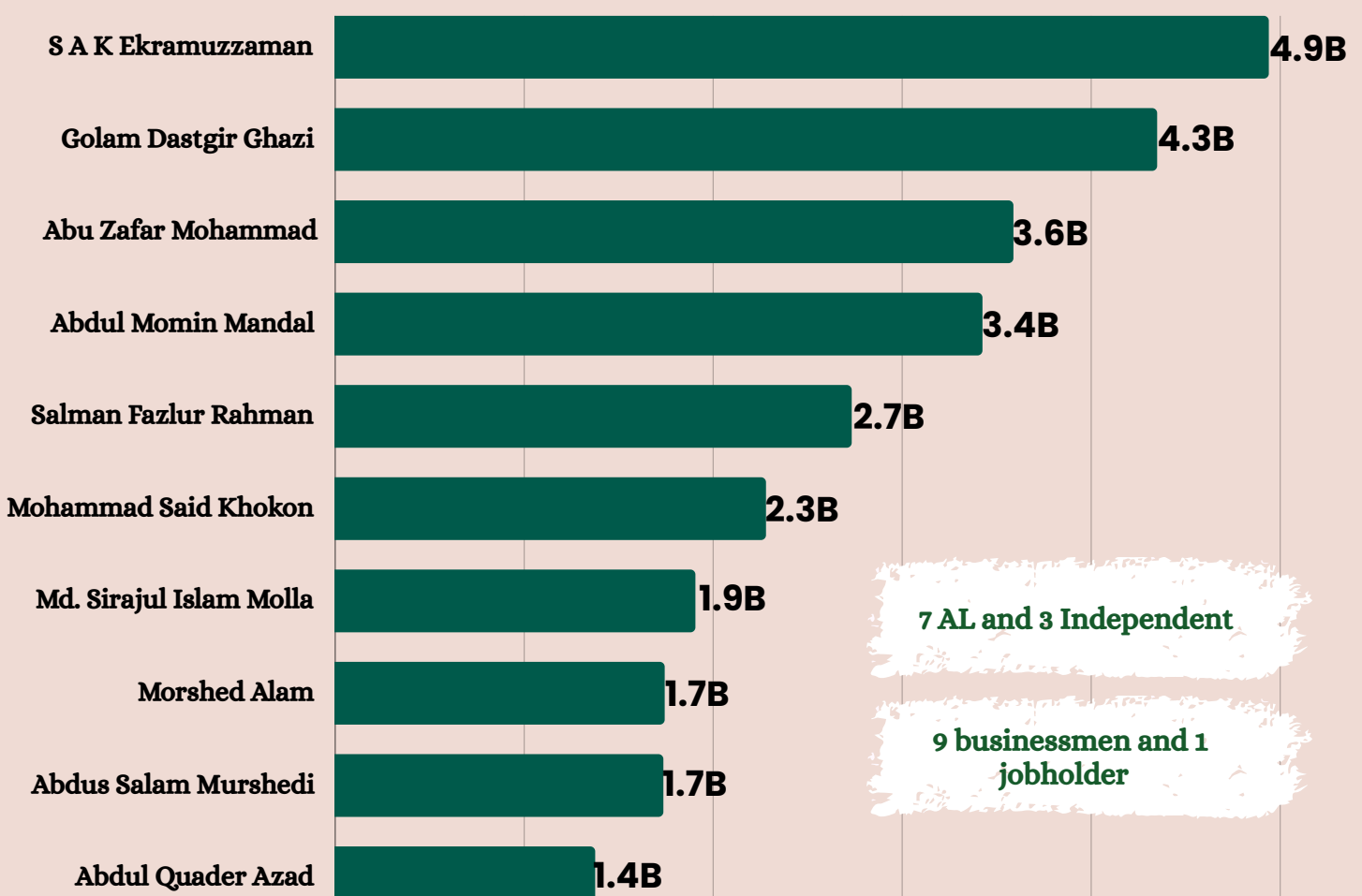


TOP 10 HIGHEST EARNING MPS
